



SPRING CONFERENCE COPED ANNOUNCEMENT

April 6, 2012 is the deadline for submitting applications for the Spring IEHA Scholarship Awards. Those chosen to receive the awards will be announced at the Spring Educational Conference. The decision criteria used by the Committee on Professional and Educational Development (COPED) to make the awards will be:

1. Candidate must be a U.S. Citizen.
2. Candidate must be an Indiana resident.
3. The applicant must be an IEHA member upon application submittal.
4. Student Member must be enrolled in an undergraduate/graduate program in Environmental Science or Engineering:
 - a. *IEHA recognizes that undergraduate programs in Environmental Sciences and Engineering may involve a variety of disciplines and course work that may not necessarily be called "Environmental Science/Engineering" in a curriculum brochure and may include Biology, Public Health, Natural Resources, etc.*
 - b. *The maximum amount that is to be awarded for a student member is approximately \$125.00 per scholarship.*
 - c. *The award will be given to the student after satisfactory completion of the class; the student will have to provide written verification such as a report card within 90 days of completion.*
 - d. *Student members must be enrolled in at least 12 credit hours per semester.*
5. An Active Member may be enrolled in at least 3 credit hours per semester and have an interest in the objectives and purposes of the association.
6. Priority is given to applicants who have not been awarded any previous scholarships through IEHA.
7. Scholarship priority order:
 - a. *First* – university, college, technical school courses (post-graduate classes have higher priority)
 - b. *Second* – workshops
 - c. *Third* – conferences (registration fees)
 - d. *Fourth* – credentialing support (exam cost not to exceed member fee)
