Jason reported (via e-mail) that the last Committee meeting was May 13. The June meeting was canceled due to scheduling conflicts. The next meeting will be July 9 at the ISDH Shadeland Offices. One poster presentation has been received as of today for the Fall Conference. The Committee is working on finalizing speakers for the Fall Conference concurrent session. The Committee hosted CPO classes in April and May which were well attended (20 in each class). The Committee is hosting a RWI Course on July 28 at the ISDH in Rice Auditorium. INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT (IDEM) LIAISON – Mike Sutton

Mike reported that there is information on the IDEM website about the air quality sulfur dioxide study as part of the Indiana State of the Air Report. IDEM needs groundwater monitoring survey volunteers for sampling.

INDIANA STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH (ISDH) LIAISON – Mike Mettler/Denise Wright

Mike reported that Patrick Sovinski has now moved from the fluoridation program to the on-site sewage systems program. The Lead and Healthy Homes Program will soon have a new health educator. The Childhood Lead Report is now on the Division's website. A couple of employees from the Food Protection Program will be leaving the agency for other employment opportunities.

BOARD OF ANIMAL HEALTH (BOAH) LIAISON - Dr. Jim Hollis

Dr. Hollis reported that the high pathogen avian influenza H5N8 is in Indiana. H5N2 avian influenza multi-state outbreak has been detected in over 223,000 fowl and over 48,000,000 have been affected (euthanized). Currently Indiana has a ban against showing fowl at 4-H events, county and state fairs.
