#### LIAISON REPORTS

#### BOARD OF ANIMAL HEALTH (BOAH) LIAISON – submitted by Denise Derrer

Denise reported that BOAH frequently receives calls and emails from citizens who want to report suspected cases of animal neglect and/or abuse. Unfortunately, BOAH often does not have the legal authority to investigate or pursue these cases. Neglect and abuse of animals is against Indiana law. The clear authority for cases involving companion animals lies with local law enforcement and (when available) animal control.

Many citizens reach out to BOAH because they are unaware of the division of authority. To help route people to the right resources, BOAH's website has a new feature: An interactive map that displays the correct contact(s) by county. The map may be found online at: <a href="https://www.in.gov/boah/animal-care-and-welfare/">https://www.in.gov/boah/animal-care-and-welfare/</a>

Local agencies may request assistance from BOAH. They will dispatch a district veterinarian to work with the local officials to do a veterinary assessment of the animals and their environment(s) and collect evidence, then write a formal report/documentation for the requesting agency. The BOAH veterinarian will make follow up visits, as needed to verify progress on recommendations. If needed, the veterinarian will testify in court as a subject matter expert.

During 2022, BOAH received 159 animal welfare complaints from 86 counties that resulted in approximately 3,500 staff hours spent on investigations and follow-up.
