**Donald W. Simpson, CFSP, MBIE** is a licensed funeral director and manager with Alexander Funeral Homes in Evansville, serving families for over 50 years. He is a Resolve Through Sharing (RTS) Counselor. He graduated from Vincennes University and Mid-American Mortuary College Funeral Program-Preceptor. He is an instructor for

Mass Fatality Classes with the Indiana Department of Homeland Security. He has been responding to local, state, national and international disasters since 1969.

**Clint Studabaker** is a retired Professional Civil/Environmental Engineer. He received his BS Civil Engineering from Purdue University, an Executive MBA from Northern Illinois University, and a MA in Teaching from National Lewis University. Mr. Studabaker's engineering and business career spans the time since the creation of the US EPA until today. Prior to retiring to Brown County in 2015, he directed project activity for numerous Fortune 500 clients for projects involving environmental and waste services, lowering environmental liabilities, and resolving wastewater, waste disposal, energy recovery, and groundwater issues. He began his career with the Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railroad as the emergency responder and environmental engineer for train derailments involving hazardous materials. He directed engineering and construction services for a premier international hazardous waste management company. He managed a business unit for environmental engineering that served clients throughout North America and around the globe. Throughout his career, projects included remediation of superfund sites, hazardous waste incinerators, waste landfills, mobile wastewater treatment units and mobile laboratories for groundwater analysis and cleanup, and energy production through landfill gas-to-energy plants. In 2018, Mr. Studabaker was appointed by the Brown County Council to serve on the Brown County Regional Sewer District Board of Directors.
