



ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SPECIALIST OF THE YEAR AWARD

ELIGIBILITY

- Nominee must be a member of the Indiana Environmental Health Association.
- Nominee must be engaged actively in the field of environmental health / public health preparedness and emergency response in the State of Indiana for two or more years.
- Nominee shall have made an outstanding (*definition: having or showing ability well above average*) contribution(s) in the field of environmental health / public health preparedness and emergency response within the past five (5) years. Such contribution(s) must have been significantly outstanding in improving and protecting the public health and welfare.
- Nominee shall have made a significant contribution(s) to the advancement of the Indiana Environmental Health Association.

AWARD

An appropriate plaque shall be presented to the Environmental Health Specialist of the Year Award recipient at the IEHA Annual Fall Educational Conference awards banquet.
